



## **ELECTRONIC DEVICE INSURANCE PROGRAM FAQ**

As part of the District's Digital Learning Program, the District is offering an electronic insurance program. This program is self-funded. All money collected through the program will go into a special account that can only be used to replace technology. Here are some key components of this program.

### **What is the cost?**

The cost of the insurance is based on a flat rate of \$20 per system. This money will be used to create a dedicated pool of funding to replace or repair insured technology. Because this is a self-funded pool, the District may need to adjust the annual cost up or down based upon usage.

### **What does the insurance cover?**

The insurance is designed to cover accidental breakage including screen breakage. In addition, the insurance will protect against spills, fire, flood, natural disasters, and theft/loss.

### **Do Families have to buy the insurance?**

No. Insurance is not mandatory. Students will be allowed to take electronic devices home (when their teachers allows it) whether they have insurance or not. As with all school equipment and materials, families will be responsible for the cost of replacing or repairing equipment if they don't purchase the insurance and something occurs to the device.

### **Can I wait to purchase the insurance?**

Insurance is available for purchase up to two weeks after devices are issued from your student's school site. Anyone electing to purchase insurance after the issuance of device will be required to present the device with all associated components.

### **Will the money collected for insurance be spent on other projects?**

All Money collected in the self-insurance pool will be placed in a special fund. This fund will only be used to replace or repair insured devices. The District will not make money on this program.

### **Am I financially responsible if the device breaks or is stolen at school?**

Yes, parents are financially responsible unless insurance has been purchased for the device.



The full replacement cost of the current device standard is identified in the following table:

**Will the insurance continue to cover the replacement device?**

Yes the insurance will continue to cover the replacement device through the end of the school year--June 30th. The maximum number of replacements will be two (2).

**My student is new to the site will we be able to get a device and purchase insurance?**

Yes, the program you students are participating in requires an issued device, then your student will be issued a device. Parents will have the option to purchase insurance.
